Discussion Questions – The Last Judgment

- What are some of the things that will happen on judgment day? (*The Son of Man will come in glory with angels; He will sit on His throne in heavenly glory.*)
- What will happen to the people? (All of the nations will be separated like shepherds separate sheep and goats, to the right and left.)
- What did Jesus mean when he said that those on his right hand had fed him, clothed him, and so on? (<u>Matthew 25:37–40</u>.)
- What will be our reward if we serve others? (<u>Matthew 25:34, 46</u>.) What will happen to those who do not serve others? (<u>Matthew 25:41, 46</u>.)
- When Jesus talked about serving "the least of these my brother and sisters" what did he mean? (*people who are unimportant in society*).
- Besides living in poverty, what other circumstances could make a person feel unimportant? (sadness or depression, having a disability.)
- What would Jesus want us to do if we knew someone who didn't have enough to eat?
- What would Jesus want us to do if you saw a kid at school who had no friends?
- What would Jesus want us to do if we knew someone who didn't have a warm coat and was very cold in the winter?
- What would Jesus want us to do if we knew someone had been at home sick for a very long time?
- Why should we help people who need food, clothing, water, or a friend?
- Have you ever been a friend to someone in need of a friend?
- Have you ever given food to someone who was hungry and didn't have food?

• You don't have to wait till you are an adult to help people in need. How can you help someone now? (*Toy and clothing drives, being a friend.*)
